## Immanuel's Music and Arts Camp

Immanuel's Music and Arts Camp is a week-long summer day camp where faith and creativity connect in a God-centered environment. The camp's mission is to offer the children in our community the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of visual and performing arts. Each elective will be taught by highly qualified teachers who will engage the campers in exciting and fun ways!

The camp culminates with a Friday-evening Closing Celebration for family and friends.

## Core Curriculum

### Daily Devo

This class will encourage campers to find their individual voices, words and courage to speak as children of God. The Bible is filled with stories of people who were led to speak boldly for God and for people in need. Each day we'll explore these stories using our creativity and imaginations.

### Art for All

Each camper will create a large weaving using multicolored yarns, fabrics, netting and other unusual materials. The children will weave a "record" of their life, including environment, seasons, favorite activities and words. Freedom to explore the innate artist found in each child will be encouraged.

### Choir Time

Every person has a voice! In choir, campers will learn fundamental choral and music skills in an energetic and fun-filled way. Music that is age appropriate will reflect the theme of this year's camp, "You Have a Voice!" Some of the music that is learned will be shared during the showcase on Friday evening.

## Elective Course Descriptions

Campers in Lower Grades (Grades 2 & 3), Middle Grades (Grades 4 & 5) and Upper Grades (Grades 6, 7 & 8) customize their camp experience by selecting the electives they would like.\* Each camper in these grades needs to select one elective from each of the three pairings below.

Primary Grades (K & 1) will have shortened class times and participate in all electives.

\*IMAC reserves the right to change the breakdown of camper groupings as necessary based on registration to ensure an appropriate camper/teacher ratio.

### Choice 1: Theater

Ever wanted to act in a play? Well, now's your chance to discover the craft of acting and the collaborative process of making theater. Through games, personal discovery, storytelling and a TON of fun and imagination, we'll learn about acting techniques and terminology as well as the other components of theater from directing to design. This class will be geared toward both beginners and those with previous experience.

### Dance

So you think you can dance? This class is great for beginners and dancers of all levels! Campers will build movement skills and learn fun choreography from many different styles of dance. Students will grow confident moving as an ensemble with attention to grounded-ness, coordination, balance, flexibility, strength and musicality. Let's dance!

### Choice 2: Crash, Bang, Boom

Do you like to make up rhythms on "found objects"? Are you always drumming on your desk at school? If you enjoy busting loose and creating music on recycled garbage, this elective is for you. We will be working with all sorts of trash and creating rhythms and even melodies out of recycled objects. No prior musical training required.

### Yoga

In this elective, young yogis will experience stretches, poses, breath work, games and relaxation. We will play and explore in a non-competitive environment. We'll work on strength, balance, self-confidence, respect for self and others, as well as finding joy and vitality in our bodies.

### Choice 3: Art in 2 Dimensions

This class is for those who love to express themselves in a creative, fun and colorful way. Throughout the week we will experiment with different materials and techniques to create our own masterpieces. We'll learn how to bring our thoughts and ideas to life using a pencil and paintbrush. Our voices will be heard through individually created works of art.

### Creative Writing

Through individual and group writing activities tailored to each age group, we'll play with words and find out just how powerful language can be.
